Tips for making a lantern:

Repurposing materials is highly encouraged.

Avoid using glass in your creation.

Give your lantern a handle or a comfortable way to carry it.

Keep it lightweight!

Do not use real flames.

Battery-operated candles or glow sticks will help protect the forest.

Not feeling creative? That's fine too. You can use a flashlight or a store-bought lantern (battery-operated).

A recommended list of what to bring:

- Good, sturdy shoes for walking
- A thermos of warm drinks if the temperature calls for it. (no alcohol)
- A few light snacks
- Personal lighting to help guide your way to your vehicle
- Clothing for the weather
- Your homemade lantern!

Items not allowed at the event:

- Open flames
- Loud music
- Tobacco products and alcohol
- Off-leash dogs
